Mr. Jim Tayoun,

Thank You for your time and consideration regarding my concerns at Veteran Stadium. Your willingness to publish what I have to say is exciting to myself and others, and deeply appreciated. Without public exposure my concerns are going to wither and die on the vine. A few are hoping this issue disappears.

As you consider your newspaper's position, realize I'm willing to document my activity audit trail. That I'm willing to give you a copy of my personal phone records and copy of my Email account with AOL during my time line of events regarding my attempted project. This will support that people either received phone calls, Email's, or a fax regarding my concerns .

Another tactic some tried was if they could somehow discredit me, by extension they could discredit my efforts. For the record I'm am not, nor ever been a government employee. I have never been arrested or have done anything that would have been a public relations liability to civilian or military concerns. Ethnically I am 50% white and 50% minority. (Puerto Rican) I am not a Veteran but was military trained in the reserves for six years staring in 1977 and honorably discharged.

My military training exposed me to Marine Special Forces, training at the Seals training base in Coronado, Arctic Warfare training with Army Rangers, finally Military Police with the Army in Washington D.C. with a basic security clearance. My corporate experience is as equally complex , with depth, utilizing different disciplines. In March of 2002 I did submit a request to work with Tom Ridge for Homeland Defense as have many thousands of people in our country.

I've made it very clear to others that I'm not even a big football or sports fan. That my concerns were solely about the name Veteran in the City of Philadelphia. For the sake of historical perspective how Veterans will be remembered in this City. As City planners continue to choreograph their message to the world about the City of Philadelphia what they say about the name Veteran in this town is as equally important.

I look forward to discussing this further, as you consider my article for publication. I am ready at your soonest opportunity.

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I have already spoken with Marines in Quantico Virginia responsible for handling the gun salutes for the President and various Commanding Generals during their tours of duty. This piece of equipment is similar in nature to what is used at the Army Navy Games. However will not be inside the stadium rather outside near an area where various static display's will be located . They will salute the Eagles and their opposing team when they score.

There is an Army Guard Unit , with history that goes all the way back to Ben Franklin. They have a Bradley Troop Carrier and a Humvie that can be used in a static display.

I have spoken with the Coast Guard about what they have for a display as well. They refer to their water craft as an RHI pontoon and I'm in the process of trying to find their spokesman for the Customs and DEA.

As you are also well aware of Vai Sikahena of NBC10 accepts challenges. In coordination with the National Anthem, an Air Force Pilot from Maguire AFB properly outfitted for Live Camera feed would be able to go vertical 180 over the stadium. The Airforce pilot will have flown ceiling cover after the Attacks of 9/11/01. For the purposes of a static display the Airforce might be able to bring an aircraft engine and mechanic crew. Without them the planes don't go up.

The Marines also have their Harrier Jump Jet, a very specialized piece of equipment that is capable of doing something special at the end of the game. Cameras in the cockpit for live feed with a local Radio Personality that has been instrumental in helping with their Toys for Tots Program. The Marines will conclude with a final salute to VETERANS STADIUM .for the annals of continued History of Philadelphia.

No single branch of the services will be allowed to do an end run around the other to hog the TV Crews. This joint military civilian operation will be used to show a United Fist. As there will be NFL national camera coverage, VFW legionaries and the rest of America will enjoy things normally experienced only by the Military, and yet to be determined in the History of the NFL and Eagles Franchise.

An on site survey for each military units safety consideration will need to be conducted in concert with civilian concerns and authority. Once this safety feasibility study is concluded then the military, NFL camera crews and civilian authorities can act in concert with one another?

I will also give a heads up to the National Head Quarters for the VFW. I've learned what will be needed to get a ladder company from a fire department. This could also be used as a repelling tower at the static display. I've started the process of communicating with various military units and senior staff authorities locally and nationally. I've located Donna Montana, for Paul Tagliabou for the commissioners office for the NFL.

As soon as possible a conceptual agreement in writing from Eagles management, and the Commissioners office for the NFL will be needed in order to bring possible military assets to the table. This agreement will allow for proper logistical, command and control, as well as training issues for the

Denise,

As the Eagles continue towards the playoff's and final victory in the Super bowl this year, I appreciate your consideration. Trying to choreograph a concept never attempted in the history of the NFL is going to be exciting. There will be different opportunities to overcome as Civilian and Military personnel continue to prove what can be accomplished when everyone pulls together. Our cultural history in Philadelphia clearly demonstrates what is possible!! This is one of many reasons why our current football icon is called VETERANS Stadium.

Like five fingers of a fist, I'm trying to bring together all the recruiters, with their possible military assets for both static and visual display. Orchestrated so that all branches get Television Media coverage before Vetererans Stadium is gone.

As part of a pre-game show a possibility is that the Armies Black Hawk Helicopters , are used in coordination with Navy Seals. By pre positioning the Seals desert terrain vehicle inside the stadium. The Armies Black Hawk Crew can insert the Seals on the 50 yard line using a spy rig or fast rope. The Seals then run to their vehicle and take 4 or 5 laps on the football field and back outside to where a staging area is established for all the branches of the services as a static display.

The Army Black Hawks are locally in New Jersey and were the flight crews used at The Twin Towers in New York on 9/11/01. These Flight Crews were also used by FBI strike teams and train with New York Police Assets. They can also bring a Field Medical Tent for a static display.

For the purposes of operational security, the Philadelphia Naval Yard would be the staging area. There are Professional Military Police at Fort Dix to supplement Naval Security. These operational assets will be well protected. I know the MP to cherry pick his team and would also be used at the static display at Vetererans Stadium to act in concert with civilian authority.

I'm aware of a former police officer with a commendation from a Secretary of the Interior aware of civilian police requirements for an event of this nature for technical advisory assistance pending his availability.

I have already spoken with Marines in Quantico Virginia responsible for handling the gun salutes for the President and various Commanding Generals during their tours of duty.
